UNITY PURPOSE:


To enhance communication and outreach among diverse elements within the fellowship of Cocaine Anonymous in the interest of carrying the message to the addict who still suffers and promote unity.


Overheard at meetings:

Step III:
"Made a decision to turn our will and life over to the care of God, as we understood Him."

The very first thing that comes to mind about this "Step," is all of the prejudices and assumptions that I brought into the rooms of "Cocaine Anonymous." I had no idea what this "Step" meant to me and I certainly wasn't going to ask any of the people in the meeting to help me to understand it or help me to personalize it. So there I was going to meetings, not using and parroting what was being said in reference to "*turning my will and my life over to the care of God, as I understand Him.*" Then all of a sudden, I had what is commonly referred to as an *Epiphany*(a sudden striking understanding of something). It's written in the Big Book of Alcoholics Anonymous, Chapter 4, We Agnostics (the first 6 lines on page 47) "When therefore, we speak to you of God, we mean your own conception of God. This applies too to other spiritual expressions which, you find in this book. Do not let any prejudice you may have about spiritual terms deter you from honestly asking yourself what they mean to you." I found out for myself that the idea of turning my will and my life over to God had nothing at all to do with police officers, parole officers, jobs, institutions or my wife or family; it had at to do with my finally being able to make a decision based on something well thought out, that I'd be willing to give to my caretaker "over to the care of God"; realizing that a caretaker is needed only when the owner is either absent or incompetent or both (as in the case of a cocaine addict) cont
